## DART buses return to regular downtown routing Friday on reopened 7th Street

Ten DART bus routes will return to regular routing through downtown Des Moines on Friday due to the reopening of 7<sup>th</sup> Street.

DART Routes 1, 3, 4, 11, 14, 15, 17, 51, 52 and 60 have been on detour through downtown since the fire at the Younkers building on March 29. The return to regular downtown routing will affect three bus stops:

- The temporary bus stop on Mulberry Street between 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed effective Friday;
- The bus stop at 7<sup>th</sup> and Walnut streets will remain closed further notice;
- The bus stop at 7<sup>th</sup> and Locust streets remains open and will now be the last stop before DART Central Station for buses headed into downtown Des Moines.

In addition, the LINK Shuttle that operates out of the Center Street Park and Ride will remain on partial detour, returning to 7<sup>th</sup> Street but remaining on detour on Mulberry Street due to an ongoing closure on Walnut Street.
